

Guidelines for Working Hunter Updated February 2009

Section 1 — Jumping	Points
Style and Manners while jumping	30
Correct hunting pace while jumping	15
Each obstacle cleared (8 obstacles—natural)	10
Each obstacle cleared - 3 marks = satisfactory 7 marks = good and 10 marks = excellent	
Penalties	
Jumping Knockdown	10
First Refusal	10
Second Refusal	20
Third Refusal	Elimination
Fall or Horse or Rider	Elimination
Course Error	Elimination

Boots, bandages and protective pads are permissible on horse legs for jumping only.

In the event of a fall the rider must leave the area unmounted.

Section 2 — Ridden Flat

Action and paces	15
Manners	15
Attire / Equipment	10

The workout should be similar to that of an open saddle class and should always include a gallop and a change of lead at the canter.

Section 3—In Hand

Type	15
Conformation	20

The Type and Conformation mark must include stripping of the animal.

Rider will dismount, unsaddle and present to the judge for a static assessment for Type and Conformation.

- No penalty is incurred if the lower pole on the same vertical is lowered.
- If an animal turns its quarters to a fence or has a complete turn around, both constitute a refusal.
- If an animal jumps the incorrect fence it will be eliminated.
- Animals displaying continued disobedience, or animals leaving the ring whether the rider is mounted or not will be eliminated;
- All riders must wear an approved safety helmet;
- Ponies 14hh and under must be ridden by rider 18 years or under;
- Horse/pony must be 4 years of age or older;
- A snaffle bridle must be used;
- Saddles may be straight cut, jumping or all purpose;
- The same saddle must be used for all sections.

Conditions for entry for the Perth Royal Show require the competitor to complete two (2) Working Hunter Events without elimination at qualifying fixtures. It is also essential for Perth Royal qualification that the horse is stripped in the flat section for the type and confirmation mark.

Flat Section Judges:

Any official Show Horse Council Judge may judge the Ridden Flat Section of the Working Hunter Class.

Jumping Section Judges:

The jumping section may only be judged by fully qualified Jumping Section Judges.
